
POCHADE BOX INSTRUCTIONS



Tighten front knob of support arm

to lock support arm in place.

- Slide support arm toward rear of box until Lift lid to desired working angle it stops. This provides all the support for and tighten lid support knob. the lid and is a VERY IMPORTANT step!
 - Tighten lid stabilizing knob.

accessory tray/brush holder



- Unlock latch on front of pochade box.

- NOTE: To open lid completely flat for

position and follow steps 2 and 3.


- Loosen the 3 knobs on left side of box.

watercolor, leave support arm in closed

The accessory tray can hold pastels and other tools and small accessories. It is held on the rear of the lid with two magnets.

- Grip accessory tray brackets and pull away from the lid.
- Attach accessory tray to
- the right side of the box.

using the palette blocks (holds the glass palette in place)



Two small magnetic block hold the tempered glass palette in place when the palette box is closed. Remove the magnetic blocks and use the hole in the bottom to push up the edge of the glass palette.





adjusting the panel holders

The pastel box can hold panels, pastel board and mounted pastel paper.

- Loosen 2 knobs on rear of lid.
- Raise or lower to
- desired position. Re-tighten knobs.

Supply Box (sold separately) The Supply Box is the perfect accessory for easy access to paints and brushes. It fits on the front two legs of the Sienna Tripod.

Adjust height of supply box on tripod with the 2 adjustable leg blocks. Set the supply box on the open Sienna Tripod. Open lid and use as a work surface.

Paper towel holder is included with supply box. It attaches on the front or sides of box.
